The 2013 Coda di Volpe C is a fresh and informal white wine that would work with finger foods and appetizers on a warm summer afternoon. The wine opens to a light straw color and a feather-light mouthfeel. Simple aromas include citrus, candied fruit, honey and a touch of wild sage. It should be consumed over the next 12 months.

Roberto Di Meo is a talented winemaker from Avellino and one of Campania's most prolific producers. He is endowed with wild energy and new ideas that are the inspiration for the many different lines of wines that characterize his ample portfolio.

The 2013 Falanghina del Sannio S is a youthful and fragrant expression of this popular grape with pretty tones of citrus, white flower, grapefruit and white mineral. It offers medium intensity and consistency on the palate. This pretty white wine exhibits balance and tonic freshness with drying tones of talc powder and flint on the close.

The 2006 Fiano di Avellino Colle dei Cerri is a solid and sophisticated white wine with pretty mineral tones that segue to dried citrus, melon, yellow rose and candied fruit. The wine is amazingly conserved and youthful despite its older age (dating almost ten years from the vintage). It is an elegantly aged and layered expression of Greco and this wine demonstrates the long aging capacity of this promising grape. Given its current track record, you can count on another five years of bottle aging.

Showing a pretty golden color, the 2013 Fiano di Avellino F offers a standard aromatic profile of the grape. You get peach, pear, honey and Golden Delicious apple and the wine's aromatic intensity is moderate but pleasing. The cooler vintage has helped to shape a zesty sense of acidity and freshness on the close followed by delicate endnotes of crushed mineral.

Yellow rose, crushed mineral, citrus and cantaloupe melon emerge from the bouquet. The wine offers great textural richness with soft, creamy consistency on the close.

Here we have it: One of the great white wines of Italy is the 2000 Fiano di Avellino Selezione Erminia Di Meo. I tasted bottle 1,264 of 3,000. If anyone has a doubt concerning the longevity of the Fiano grape, I urge you to seek out the other 2,999 bottles out there somewhere. In the great tradition of France or Germany, Campania proves its worth with a wine that tastes young and tonic despite its 15 years of age. I loved the dried fruit and mineral definition and the silky structure that keeps this wine so fresh and relevant in the mouth. It shows minimal signs of oxidation. I'm going to bet on an extra long cellar life for this gorgeous Fiano.

Di Meo's 2013 Greco di Tufo G is a rich and floral expression of the grape with white rose, peach and almond blossom. The bouquet is extremely focused, fresh and fragrant, more so than its peers. Mineral notes of brimstone and crushed rock add pretty detailing at the back with very delicate touches of green olive and dried sage. This is a great lunchtime wine to enjoy over the next 24 months.

Dry and sophisticated, the 2010 Greco di Tufo G Selezione RDM is another wonderful surprise from vintner Roberto Di Meo. The wine is released five years after the harvest. The bouquet and the mouthfeel hardly show any signs of aging. Instead, you get a sturdy, important expression of Greco with yellow fruit, dried lemon zest, peach, pear and almond skin. The natural fragrance of the Greco grape sings load and clear.

Part of a special limited edition collectors' release, the 2007 Taurasi Riserva Selezione Hamilton is a massive wine with impressive muscle, power and brawn. It exhibits an evolved appearance with a blackish color and impenetrable appearance. There's not much in the way of fruit and what you do get resembles dried cherry and blackcurrant. The wine is tight and astringent with the kind of untamed tannin you often get with the mighty Aglianico grape. Selezione Hamilton is all about austerity, strength and volume. There is nothing subtle about it. I can't help but mention the fantastic label that depicts all sorts of fiery scenes of an exploding Vesuvius at the time of Pompeii.

The 2006 Taurasi Riserva T opens to a black-garnet color and thick concentration. The bouquet is somewhat evolved with dried blackberries, tar, licorice, balsam herb, rum cake and crushed granite. This is a big wine, with broad shoulders and deep footprints. The mouthfeel is weighty and thick with smokey flavors of ash and campfire that linger long on the palate. The finish is crisper than you might expect and there's a touch of sour cherry there as well. The balanced 2006 vintage still has a lot of life inside.
