## TAURASI RISERVA VIGNA OLMO 2015

Drinking Window: 2023 - 2040

**Vigna Olmo is the cru managed by Roberto Di Meo in the village of Montemarano.**

The vines are 29 years old, harvested in early November. **But the key is the altitude, at about 870 metres above sea level.** Restrained notes of cassis and graphite with some bloodiness, then a blood orange flavour with a gianduia aftertaste. **This Riserva shines for the refinement of its tannins, the velvety, almost-creamy palate of stunning quality and amazing length, and the tension of its cassis and cigar leaf finish. Great Taurasi.**
