With the just released 2010 Vittorio, Roberto Di Meo proves yet again the incredible aging potential of Greco di Tufo when planted in the right sites and made with care. Combining freshness and the complexity that comes with age, it has an earthy finesse and loads of personality, opening with aromas recalling scorched earth, dried stone fruit, truffle and dried yellow wild flower. The savory palate has a smooth, glycerine-like texture that wraps around mature apricot, dried pineapple slice, unsweetened lemon drop and grilled sage all underpinned by an intense smoky minerality. Bright acidity keeps it energized. While this is definitely ready, with proper cellaring I see this maintaining at this level for another several years. Drink through 2030.
